## ROYAL BOROUGH of GREENWICH ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1) OVERMEAD & AVERY HILL ROAD SLIP ROAD PLANNED ROAD CLOSURE (ORDER)

- The Royal Borough of Greenwich intends to make this Order in exercise of powers under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. This is to facilitate works by Southern Gas Networks who need to carry out gas main upgrades.
- 2. The Order will come into operation on 24/07/25 and would continue to be valid for 18 months. However, the works are expected to take 33 days. The duration of the Order can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.
- 3. The effect of the Order would be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering, exiting, proceeding, or waiting (including waiting for the purposes of loading or unloading) in to Overmead at the junction of Halfway Street, and to allow two-way traffic at the junction of Avery Hill Road. Also to prohibit vehicles from entering the Slip Road in Avery Hill Road at the junction of Halfway Street.
- 4. Whilst the Order is in operation traffic will be diverted via the placing of the appropriate signage. Prohibitions remain in force; pedestrians are not affected, and vehicle access will be maintained wherever possible.
- Nothing in this Notice will apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or traffic warden, to emergency service vehicles, or to vehicles being used in connection with the works.
- The restrictions described above will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs as prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
