ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3 GLA ROAD (HOOK RISE NORTH, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KINGSTON UPON THAMES) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable Telecom works to take place on Hook Rise North.
 The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping on Hook
- Rise North between its junction with Princes Avenue and the extended common boundary of Nos. 34 and 36 Hook Rise North.

 The Order will be effective between 15th July 2025 and 18th July 2025, each night, from 10:00 PM until 5:00 AM, or when the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and

to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
