## TEMPORARY PARKING, STOPPING, WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS WEAVER WALK

- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable a crane operation to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intends to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily;
  - a) ban any vehicle from entering, proceeding or waiting (including waiting for the purposes of loading and unloading a vehicle) at any time, in that length of Weaver Walk which lies between Chapel Road and the northern property boundary of Nos. 2-8 Weaver Walk;
  - b) close the footpath on the western side of Weaver Walk which lies between Chapel Road and the northern property boundary of Nos. 2-8 Weaver Walk. Access to any adjoining properties will be maintained.
- 2. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 3. The Order would come into force on 12 September 2025 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect on 12 and 13 September 2025, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at subsequent dates and times within the maximum period of 1 month.
