(b) outside and opposite Nos. 3A and 3B Webber Street and the junction of Mitre Road.

- 3. Mitre Road, both sides, to suspend the parking bays between the junction of Webber Street and No. 101 to 105 Mitre Road.
- 4. Short Street to ban heavy goods vehicles turning left or right from Short Street into Mitre Road.
- 5. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Short Street, Ufford Street and Webber Street and vice versa.
- o. Alternative routes for alrected vehicles would be available via Short seaball, from time to time, be indicated by the placing of the appropria
- The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
 The Order would come into force on 8 September 2025 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month, or until the works have

been completed whichever is sooner.
