- 2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time in: LAVINGTON STREET. (2a) Between Great Suffolk Street and Ewer Street (2b) Whole length from Great Suffolk Street to Southwark Street.
- EWER STREET, (2c) at the junction of Lavington Street. 3. The alternative routes for affected traffic will be: i) Southwark Street, Blackfriars Road, Union Street, Great Suffolk Street. ii) Union Street, Great Guildford Street, Southwark Street.
- 4. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the
- 5 direction of a police constable in uniform.
- The closure will be in operation on the following dates; Works to be completed in 2 phases, 2a 6. and 2c. and 2b. Between the 22nd of September to the 7th of November 2025.
