

# **LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK**

## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1) (NEEDLEMAN STREET)**

### **(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable gas mains works by SGN or its appointed contractor, it intends to make an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named road.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time in: NEEDLEMAN STREET, at the junction with Surrey Quays Road for a distance of approximately 20 metres into Needleman Street.
3. The alternative routes for affected traffic will be;  
Diversion Route 1 - Surrey Quays Road, Redriff Road, Salter Road, Lagado Mews, Timber Pond Road, Poolmans Street  
Diversion Route 2: Poolmans Street, Timber Pond Road, Lagos Mews, Salter Road, Brunel Road, Lower Road
4. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
5. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
6. The closure will be in operation on the 15th of September until the 12th of October 2025.
