  - (2) vehicle from entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Union Street from its junction with Blackfriars Road to the eastern vehicular access point to Roland Hill House, Union Street;
  - (3) vehicle except pedal cycles from entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on The Cut between its junctions with Blackfriars Road and Joan Street.

The Order will also allow:

(I) two way working on Union Street between its junctions with Gambia Street and the eastern vehicular access to Roland Hill House

The Order will be effective between the dates of 30th August 2025 and 31st August 2025 and 4th October 2025 and 12th October 2025 every Saturday at 7.00 AM until Sunday at 7.00 PM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs for traffic travelling in a Southerly direction on Blackfriars Road via Stamford Street, Waterloo Road and St George's Circus to normal route of travel. for traffic travelling in a northerly direction via Borough Road, Southwark Bridge Road and Southwark Street to normal route of travel.
