ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2 GLA ROAD (NEW CROSS ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2025

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable carriageway resurfacing works to take place at A2 New Cross Road in the London Borough of Lewisham.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (I) entering Pepys Road at its junction with Queen's Road/New Cross Road;
 - (2) stopping at the southern kerb line of New Cross Road between its junctions with Pepys Road and the Unnamed access Road to New Cross Garage;
 - (3) stopping in the Parking and Disabled Persons' Vehicle Bay at the eastern kerbline of Pepys Road adjacent to No. 186 New Cross Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times on the 7th September 2025 from 8.00 AM until 12.00 PM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via New Cross Road, Queen's Road, Erlanger Road and Sherwin Road to normal route of travel.
