- Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that on 18 September 2025 it has made the above 1. Order under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of, Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The effects of the Order, for the purpose of facilitating the uses of the re-developed building at the site of former Nos. 49-53 Glengall Road, are to:
 - install two new inset 'unlimited stay' Disabled Persons' parking places side-by- side in (a) GLENGALL ROAD (each 6.6 metres in length) on the north-east side opposite Nos. 68
 - 72 Glengall Road which would operate 'at any time' and may be used without time limit by vehicles displaying a valid Disabled Persons' 'blue badge';

install new inset loading bays operating every day of the week, for the purpose of loading only between 7 am and 7 pm (40 minutes maximum stay, and no return within 2 hours) in (i) BIANCA ROAD on the south-east side 47.5 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line build-out of Glengall Road (13.5 metres in length), and (ii) GLENGALL ROAD two loading bays on the north-east side opposite Nos. 76 - 80 Glengall Road (15 metres in length) and opposite the side of No. 6 Brideale Close (13.5 metres in length); and

to remove a total of approximately 55 metres of existing 'at any time' waiting restrictions

- (double vellow lines) in BIANCA ROAD and GLENGALL ROAD to accommodate the new inset 'unlimited stay' Disabled Persons' parking places and the new inset loading bays, and at the locations described above. Notes: (1) 'at any time' means at all hours on every day of the week. (2) All measurements are approximate.
