ROYAL BOROUGH of GREENWICH ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1) THAMES FOOTPATH (OLYMPIAN WAY) PLANNED FOOTPATH CLOSURE (ORDER)

- The Royal Borough of Greenwich makes this Order in exercise of powers under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. This is
 to facilitate works by Heidelberg Materials who need to carry out upgrades works on the Thames Footpath.
- The Order will come into operation on 1st October 2025 and would continue to be valid for 18 months. However, the works are expected to take only 10 months. The duration of the Order can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.
- The effect of the Order would be to temporarily prohibit cyclists and pedestrian from entering, exiting, proceeding, or waiting in the Thames Footpath to the rear of 231 to 263 Tunnel Avenue.
- Whilst the Order is in operation no traffic diversions for vehicles will be required. The prohibitions remain in force; cyclists and pedestrians will be diverted accordingly by the placement of appropriate signage.
- 5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or traffic warden,
- to emergency service vehicles, or to vehicles being used in connection with the works.

 6. The restrictions described above will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs as prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
