ROYAL BOROUGH of GREENWICH ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 — SECTION 14(1) BLACKWALL LANE PLANNED LANE CLOSURE (ORDER)

- The Royal Borough of Greenwich intends to make this Order in exercise of powers under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. This is to facilitate works by NG Tunnelling who need to carry out the installation of a new sewer connection.
- The Order will come into operation on 22nd September 2025 and would continue to be valid for 18 months. However, the works are expected to take 14 days. The duration of the Order can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.
- The effect of the Order would be to temporarily suspend the operation of the bus lane and to implement a contraflow system on Blackwall Lane, outside or opposite 87. The during the contraflow operation local traffic will be permitted and directed to use the bus lane.
- Whilst the Order is in operation no traffic diversions will be required. Existing prohibitions will remain in effect; pedestrians are not
 affected, and vehicular access will be maintained.

Nothing in this Notice will apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or traffic warden, to emergency service vehicles, or to vehicles being used in connection with the works.

The restrictions described above will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs as prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
