

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1)
(ABBEY STREET, GILKES CRESCENT, GILKES PLACE)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable various works to be carried out, it made, an order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named roads.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload at any time in:
 - (2a) Abbey Street, between Enid Street and Druid Street
 - (2b) Gilkes Crescent, between Calton Avenue and 34 Gilkes Crescent
 - (2c) Gilkes Place, between Dulwich Village and its blocked end by Gilkes Crescent
3. The alternative routes for affected traffic will be (2a) as indicated by the signs displayed (2b) Calton Avenue, Townley Road, East Dulwich Grove, Gilkes Crescent (2c) not applicable
4. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
5. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
6. The closure will be in operation on the following dates (2a) 7th – 12th December (2b) 8th December (2c) 8th December

THE A3 GLA ROAD (BOROUGH HIGH STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) (NO.2) ORDER 2025

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable gully installation works to take place at A3 Borough High Street.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping on Borough High Street between its junctions with Southwark Street and Talbot Yard.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 9.30 AM on the 15th December 2025 until 5.00 PM on the 14th January 2026 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO VARY THE LATE NIGHT LEVY IN THE LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK

Part 2, Chapter 2 of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011
The Late Night Levy (Application and Administration) Regulations 2012
The Late Night Levy (Expenses, Exemptions and Reductions) Regulations 2012

The London Borough of Southwark is hereby giving notice of its proposal to vary the late night levy that was introduced on 1 September 2019 to include premises licensed to provide the provision of late night refreshment between midnight and 6am (00:00 to 06:00 hours) in the borough of Southwark.

A Summary of the proposed Variation is:

1. The Council's proposed variation of the late night levy will be introduced on 01 April 2026.
2. The Council's proposed late night supply period will begin at 00:00hrs and end at 06:00hrs.
3. The Council propose the following permitted categories of premises will be exempt from paying the levy as defined in the Late Night Levy (Expenses, Exemptions and Reductions) Regulations 2012:
 - Premises with overnight accommodation, where the provision of late-night refreshment can only be supplied to persons staying at the premises for consumption on the premises.
 - Theatres and cinemas.
 - Bingo Halls.
 - Community Amateur Sports Clubs.
 - Community premises.
4. The Council proposes that a reduction of 30% be granted to premises that are within a defined Business Improvement District (BID) as defined in regulations 5 (1) (a) and 5 (4) of the above Expenses, Exemptions and Reductions Regulations 2012.
5. The Council is not proposing to apply any other exemptions or reductions.
6. The Council will allow Licence holders to make an application to vary their Licence under sections 41A or 86A (minor variation) of the Licensing Act 2003. There will be no fee for such a valid application provided it is received by the Council within the 2-month period directly following the date of a formal decision notice to vary the Levy. This applies only to the reduction of licensed hours for the provision of late-night refreshment so they do not fall within the operational hours of the Levy (00:00 to 06:00 hours).

The Council would like to hear your views on its proposal to vary the Late Night Levy within the London Borough of Southwark. Please note that there is a 4 week consultation period therefore the Council must receive your views from 24 November 2025 and no later than midnight on 22 December 2025, otherwise we will not be able to consider them.


