

LICENSING ACT 2003

APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF PREMISES LICENCE

Francesco Marzano has applied to the London Borough of Lambeth to vary a Premises Licence, in respect of the following premises:

Italian Bistro, 32 Streatham High Road, London, SW16 1DB

The nature of the variation is as follows:

We would like to be able to serve alcohol to our customers with or without hot food. We will also be selling late night.

We are also applying to be able to sell late night refreshments between the hours of 23:00 and 00:00 from Monday to Sunday

A responsible authority or any other person may make representation to the licensing authority in respect of this application.

Representations must be made in writing, either by post to the above address, or by email to licensing@lambeth.gov.uk and must be received no later than **12/12/2025**

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with a licensing application, and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for that offence shall not exceed level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
