ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS, HAWARDEN GROVE AND GUERNSEY GROVE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water to carry out water mains replacement works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth has made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding, parking or waiting, including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading a vehicle in the following lengths of Hawarden Grove and Guernsey Grove:

- (a) Phase one:
Hawarden Grove, between its junction with Rosendale Road and No. 47 Hawarden Grove.
- (b) Phase two:
Guernsey Grove, between its junction with Croxted Road and No. 1 Guernsey Grove.
- (c) Phase three:
Hawarden Grove, between its junction with Croxted Road and No. 10 Hawarden Grove.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available for each phase of works via:

- (a) Phase one:
Croxted Road, Guernsey Grove and Rosendale Road and vice versa.
- (b) Phase two:
Rosendale Road, Hawarden Grove and Croxted Road and vice versa.
- (c) Phase three:
Croxted Road, Guernsey Grove and Rosendale Road and vice versa.

3. The Order will come into force on 2 February 2026 and continue for a maximum duration of 3 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will take 3 weeks to complete. If the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time, then the Order may have effect on subsequent dates within the maximum period of 3 months.
