

LICENSING ACT 2003

Application has been made by Ace K 888 Ltd to the Licensing Authority of London Borough of Southwark for a Premises Licence for The Manor Club, 140-142 Walworth Road, Walworth, London, SE17 1JL. The application is to permit: the sale of alcohol for consumption on and off the premises, films, live music, recorded music and late-night refreshment between 1000 and 0200 Sunday to Thursday and 1000 and 0300 on Fridays and Saturdays and until 0330 on New Years Eve. NB: There is already a premises licence in place at this premises for these activities and these hours. The application is to separate the basement from the remainder of the licensed premises and thus have 2 premises licences.
