THE A214 AND A306 GLA ROADS AND GLA SIDE ROADS (LONDON BOROUGHS OF WANDSWORTH AND LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2026

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable highway lining and signage works to take place on the A214 Trinity Road/ Tooting Bec Road and the A306 Roehampton Lane.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - stopping on the A214 Tooting Bec Road/ Trinity Road between its junctions with Windmill Road and Garrad's Road;
 - stopping on the A306 Roehampton Lane between its junctions with Upper Richmond Road and Kingston Road;
 - entering or proceeding on the A214 southbound on-slip road connecting North Side Wandsworth Common and Trinity Road southbound;
 - turning right from Trinity Road northbound into Windmill Road;
- The Order will also permit:
 - all vehicles to use the northbound and southbound bus lanes on the A214 Tooting Bec Road/ Trinity Road between its junctions with Windmill Road and Garrad's Road;
 - all vehicles to use the northbound and southbound bus lanes on the A306 Roehampton Lane between its junctions with Upper Richmond Road and Kingston Road.

Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 12:01 AM on 26th January 2026 until 5:00 AM on 26th September 2026 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs. For Windmill Road via Trinity Road northbound, Wandsworth Roundabout and Trinity Road southbound to normal route of travel. For slip closure via North Side Wandsworth Common, Huguenot Place, East Hill eastbound, A214 northbound on-slip road, Trinity Road, Wandsworth Roundabout and Trinity Road to normal route of travel.

PROPOSAL TO MAKE AMENDMENTS TO PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE ZONES AND VARIOUS PARKING, WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS IN KENNINGTON OVAL

(This notice is about proposals to make amendments to the extents of current pedestrian and cycle zones and to introduce Loading Places and Taxi Parking Places in Kennington Oval. This would involve amendments to the locations of Permit Parking Places and Disabled Persons Parking Places to accommodate these proposals.)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth proposes to make The Lambeth (Moving Traffic Restrictions) (Amendment No. **) Order 202*, The Lambeth (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 202* and The Lambeth (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. *) Order 202* under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Moving Traffic Restrictions Order would be to revoke, relocate and re-impose the prohibition of motor vehicles:

- "At Any Time" in Kennington Oval from the north-eastern kerb-line of Harleyford Road to the vehicular access to St. Mary's School;
- between the hours of 8:15a.m. and 9:15a.m. and 2.45p.m. and 3.45p.m. Monday to Friday in Kennington Oval, from the vehicular access to St. Mary's School to the western kerb-line of Vauxhall Street. Access will be maintained for drivers holding a "LS32" permit.

3. The general effect of the Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions Order would be to:

- revoke, relocate and re-impose Disabled Persons Parking Places in Kennington Oval;
- the north-east side, from a point 8.80 metres south-east of the common boundary of Nos. 15 and 16 Kennington Oval south eastward for a distance of 6.60 metres;
- the south-west side, from a point 6.10 metres south-east of the north-western kerb-line of Clayton Street south-eastward for a distance of 6.60 metres and reduce in length existing "At Any Time" Waiting Restrictions following the creation of this Disabled Persons Parking Place.

(b) prohibit waiting, including for the purpose of loading or unloading "At Any Time" except for taxis on the north-eastern side of Kennington Oval from a point 15.40 metres south-east of the common boundary of Nos. 15 and 16 Kennington Oval south eastward for a distance of 16.60 metres.

(c) prohibit waiting, including for the purpose of loading or unloading "At Any Time" in Kennington Oval:

- the south-western side from a point 3.60 metres south east of the north western kerb-line of Clayton Street north westward for a distance of 41.90 metres;
- the south-eastern side from a point opposite the south western flank wall of Grace House, north eastward for a distance of 1.00 metre.

(d) designate a free loading place on the north-western side of Kennington Oval from a point 1.40 metres south-west of the western flank wall of Grace House northward for a distance of 10 metres to operate between 8.30a.m. and 6.30p.m. Monday to Friday with a maximum stay of 40 minutes;

4. The general effect of the Charged-For Parking Places Order would be to amend Parking Places so as to:-

- reduce in length existing Permit Parking Places in Kennington Oval following the creation of new Disabled Persons Parking Places, Taxi Parking Places and Loading Places;
- revoke Permit Parking Places in Kennington Oval:
- the south-west side, between a point 3.60 metres south-east of the north western kerb-line of Clayton Street and a point 3.00 metres north-west of that kerb-line;
- the south-west side, between a point 17.60 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Clayton Street and a point 38.30 metres north-west of that kerb-line.


