

# Transport for London Public Notice

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

### THE A202 GLA ROAD (PECKHAM HIGH STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2026

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable resurfacing works to take place at A202 Peckham High Street.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
  - (1) entering, exiting or proceeding in a southerly direction on Peckham Hill Street between its junctions with Goldsmiths Road and Peckham High Street. local access will be maintained between Goldsmiths Road and the unnamed access Road to the rear of Nos. 126 to 130 Peckham Hill Street and Nos. 95 to 107 Peckham High Street;
  - (2) stopping at the northern kerb-line on Peckham High Street between its junctions with Peckham Hill Street and Mission Place.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 11th February 2026 and 10th August 2026 every night from 10.00 PM until 4.00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Commerical Way, Naylor Road and Meeting House Lane to normal route of travel. Goldsmith Road and Meeting House Lane to normal route of travel.
