NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF PREMISES LICENCE

NOTICE IS GIVEN THAT James Matthew Stell has applied to London Borough of Southwark on 05 February 2026 to vary the premises licence at London Bridge Rooftop, 1 Colechurch House, London Bridge Walk, SE1 2SX so as to (A) Vary the layout plans by including part of lower floor within licence demise, and (B) Vary the terminal hour for all permitted activities to 23:30 Sunday to Wednesday and 01:30 Thursday to Saturday, as more particularly set out in the application.
