

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH

GODING STREET PEDESTRIAN ZONE

[NOTE: This notice is about continuing on a permanent basis the pedestrian zone in the southern section of Goding Street where motor vehicles are prohibited except for loading which was initially introduced on an experimental basis.]

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth on 16 March 2026 made the Lambeth (Moving Traffic Restrictions) (Amendment No. 14) Order 2026, the Lambeth (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 70) Order 2026 and the Lambeth (Free Parking Places, Loading Places, and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 76) Order 2026 under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

1. The general effect of the Moving Traffic Order will be to prohibit motor vehicles from entering Goding Street south of New Spring Gardens Walk except for the purpose of loading or unloading for a maximum of 40 minutes with a no return period of 2 hours.

2. The general effect of the Charged-For Parking Places Order will be to revoke business permit holder parking places and shared use parking places in Goding Street between its junction with New Spring Gardens Walk and its southern most extremity.

3. The general effect of the Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions Order will be to:-

- (a) prohibit waiting "At Any Time", including for the purpose of loading or unloading in certain lengths of Goding Street;
- (b) designate parking places for the purpose of leaving solo motorcycles on the east side of Goding Street;
- (c) designate parking places for the purpose of leaving E-scooters and dockless bikes.

4. A copy of each of the Orders, which will come into operation on 21 March 2026 of a map of the relevant area and of the relevant Orders of 2023 and 2024 (and of the Orders which have amended those Orders) can be inspected at the offices of Lambeth Council's Parking and Enforcement Group (Parking, Network Management & Fleet), 3rd Floor, Civic Centre, 6 Brixton Hill, London SW2 1EG, between 9.30 am and 4.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive (except on bank/public holidays). 6. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
