

**Notice of Application to Vary a Premises Licence made

The Proposed variation is as follows:

This condition does not apply to premises staff, performing artists and those who temporarily leave the premises for the purpose of smoking a cigarette. Those persons who leave and re-enter the premises shall be subject to a further search on the re-entry to the premises.”
