ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1)

(TEMPORARY WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS (UNION STREET))

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice, that, it made, an order, the effect of which would be to introduce 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions as detailed below.
2. Whilst the restriction is in place, and whilst the authorised traffic signs/road markings are displayed, no person shall cause any vehicle to park or wait, including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading at any time in:
 - (a) UNION STREET, 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions will be introduced between, Blackfriars Road and Gambia Street on both sides of the carriageway.
3. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, insofar as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
4. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
5. The restriction will come into force on the 14th – 15th, 21st – 22nd and the 28th – 29th March 2026, during the hours of 06:00hrs – 20:00hrs
