THE A200 GLA ROAD (CRUCIFIX LANE, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2026

- Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable Network Rail works to take place at A200 Crucifix Lane in the London Borough of Southwark.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any:
 - vehicle from stopping on Druid Street between its junctions with Brunswick Court and Crucifix Lane;
 - vehicle from entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Druid Street/ Crucifix Lane between its junctions with Whites Ground and Barnham Street. Local access will be maintained between its junctions with Tower Bridge Road and Whites Ground;
 - pedestrian from proceeding on Druid Street/Crucifix Lane between its junctions with Barnham Street and Brunswick Court.

The Order will be effective between 30th March 2026 and 1st April 2026, 13th April 2026 and 14th April 2026, 3rd August 2026 and 5th August 2026, 17th August 2026 and 18th August 2026 every night from 10.00 PM until 6.00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via White's Ground, Bermondsey Street, Tooley Street and Barnham Street to normal route of travel. for pedestrians via Great Yard and Barnham Street to normal route of travel.

SCHOOL STREETS PROGRAMME: ILDETON PRIMARY SCHOOL

The London Borough of Southwark (Pedestrian and cycle zones) (Ilderton Primary School) Traffic Order 2026

- Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that on 26 March 2026 it has made the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- The effects of the Order are to introduce a new 'school streets' timed pedestrian and cycle zone in parts of BRAMCOTE GROVE and VARCOE ROAD (which will affect access to GERARDS CLOSE and private road Eagle Close), in the vicinity of Ilderton Primary School, as part of the Council's School Streets Programme of active travel measures to encourage road safety and improve air quality in the areas surrounding primary schools.

All motor vehicles, except permit holders, would be prohibited from entering or proceeding in the entire part of BRAMCOTE GROVE that lies south of its junction with Verney Road and that part of VARCOE ROAD that lies south of its junction with Verney Road and up to a point 17.5 metres west of the north-western kerb-line build-out of Bramcote Grove, between 8.30 am and 9.30 am and between 3.00 pm and 4.00 pm (Monday to Friday, during school term time, as determined by Ilderton Primary School). Access to GERARDS CLOSE (and private road Eagle Close) are affected during the operation of the above-mentioned 'school streets' restriction, and so are included within the new 'school streets' timed pedestrian and cycle zone.

Permits allowing vehicles to enter the 'school streets' timed pedestrian and cycle zone would be available to residents of premises located within the zone, to registered carers or residents of premises located within the zone, to disabled person's blue badge holders who are school staff, carers or dropping off and/or collecting pupils to the school and to SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities) vehicles, by application to the Council. Exemptions would also apply in respect of emergency service vehicles.


