

## LICENSING ACT 2003

### APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF PREMISES LICENCE

**Brazil Cafe Ltd** has applied to the London Borough of Lambeth to vary a Premises Licence, in respect of the following premises:

The nature of the variation is as follows:  
To extend the sale of alcohol hours (on and off) Fridays and Saturdays from 00:00 to 00:30am; to add regulated entertainment and late night refreshment Friday and Saturday from 23:00 until 00:30.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with a licensing application, and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for that offence shall not exceed level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
