### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

#### **TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – TYERS TERRACE**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water to carry out water mains replacement works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order, the effect of which would be to

- (a) temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding, waiting, including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading a vehicle or parking in the length of Tyers Terrace between its junctions with Vauxhall Street and St Oswald's Place.
- (b) temporarily introduce a one-way traffic system in the lengths of Tyers Terrace between its junctions with Vauxhall Street and St Oswald's Place, from north-east to south-west.

2. The alternative route for affected cyclists by the road closure outlined in (1)(a) above would be available via St Oswald's Place, Kennington Lane and Vauxhall Street.

3. The Order would come into force on 20 April 2026 and continue in force for a maximum duration of 3 months, to allow for contingencies, or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will take 5 weeks to complete.
