

## LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK

### SHORNCLIFFE ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

#### *The London Borough of Southwark (Free Parking Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Shorncliffe Road improvements) Order 2026*

1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that on 16 April 2026 it has made the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The effects of the Order, that are in SHORNCLIFFE ROAD and ALBANY ROAD for the purpose of improving the area (near Walworth Academy) and accommodating a new raised 'zebra' pedestrian crossing and kerb-line changes (footway widening) in Shorncliffe Road, are to:-
  - (a) in SHORNCLIFFE ROAD install two new inset 'unlimited stay' Disabled Persons' parking places on the south-west and north-west side o/s Walworth Academy, 5 metres ('m') each in length, which would operate 'at any time' and may be used without time limit by vehicles displaying a valid Disabled Persons' 'blue badge', and remove a total of 14m existing 'at any time' waiting restrictions (double yellow lines 'DYLs') at these locations to accommodate the new bays;
  - (b) in SHORNCLIFFE ROAD north-west side (i) remove 24.5m existing 'School Keep Clear' markings which are no longer needed, (ii) convert 35m of existing 'timed' waiting restrictions (single yellow lines) with contiguous 'timed' loading restrictions (single kerb blips) to new 'DYLs', and (iii) add 5m new 'DYLs' to accommodate the removal of a vehicle cross-over; and
  - (c) amend existing 'DYLs' (i) throughout SHORNCLIFFE ROAD on both sides, and (ii) in ALBANY ROAD on the north-west side (south-west of its junction with Shorncliffe Road) to accommodate kerb-line changes.

*Notes: (1) 'at any time' means at all hours on every day of the week. (2) 'DYLs' refer to 'at any time' waiting restrictions. (3) All measurements are in metres and are approximate.*

3. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
