SOUTH BERMONDSEY AND PECKHAM TRAFFIC CALMING

1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that:-
 - (a) under sections 90A to 90I of the Highways Act 1980 and in accordance with the provisions of the Highways (Road humps) Regulations 1999 and the Highways (Traffic calming) Regulations 1999, will construct road humps of sinusoidal cross-section construction, approximately 3.7 metres in length, having a maximum height of 100 millimetres and covering the greater width of the carriageway in COMMERCIAL WAY (i) centred approximately 37 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Peckham Hill Street, (ii) centred approximately 10.5 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Radnor Road, and (iii) centred approximately 16 metres south-west of the western kerb-line of Peckham Park Road; and
 - (b) under section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, approval for the provision of a new 'zebra' pedestrian crossing in SOUTHWARK PARK ROAD the centre of which would be located at a point approximately 6 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line build-out of Monnow Road.

'Zig-zag' markings, on which vehicles would be prohibited from stopping at all times, will be laid on the carriageway on both sides of the road for a distance up to approximately 16.5 metres east of the crossing and for a distance up to approximately 12.5 metres west of the crossing.
