TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

The Lewisham (Prescribed Routes) (No.*) Order 202* Garthorne Road, SE23

- 1.** The Council of the London Borough of Lewisham propose to make the above mentioned Order under Section 6 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 "the Act" (as amended), the effect of which will be to:- (a) prohibit motor vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Garthorne Road, SE23 at its junction with Grierson Road southwards to a point 3m south of the party wall of Nos.6 and 8; (b) revoke "The Lewisham (Prescribed Route) (No. 6) Traffic Order 1988 which imposes a prohibition of motor vehicles in Garthorne Road above, in its entirety.
- 2.** Exemptions apply (a) for pedal cycles; (b) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; (c) to any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or 67 of the Act.

- 5.** All written representations received concerning Traffic Regulation Orders are public documents that may be inspected by any person on demand.
