

LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1) (ASYLUM ROAD)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable utility works, it has made an order, the effect of which is to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named road.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs are in place no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload on Asylum Road, between Studholme Street and Clifton Crescent.
3. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
4. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
5. The road closure will be in place between the 24th of August and 6th of September 2026.
6. A signed diversion will be in place.
7. This order remains valid for 18 months from the 2nd of July 2026. Further information may be obtained by contacting Road Network Management at ttmo@southwark.gov.uk
