

LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1) (ROCKINGHAM STREET)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable bridge inspection works by Network Rail or its appointed contractor, it has made an order, the effect of which is to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named road.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs are in place no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload on Rockingham Street, under the railway bridge between Bath Terrace and Tiverton Street.
3. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
4. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
5. The road closure will be in place from 10pm on the 17th of August until 5am on the 18th of August 2026.
6. This order remains valid for 18 months from the 30th of July 2026. Further information may be obtained by contacting Network Management at tmo@southwark.gov.uk
