

LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1) (RUSHWORTH STREET, KING JAMES STREET)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable utility works by UK Power Networks, it has made an order, the effect of which is to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named roads.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs are in place no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload on
 - (a) Rushworth Street, from the junction with King James Street to number 52 Rushworth Street.
 - (b) King James Street, between Rushworth Street and Silex Street.
3. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
4. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
5. The road closure will be in place on the following dates (a) 17th to the 21st of August 2026
(b) 24th of August to the 4th of September 2026.
6. A signed diversion will be in place.
7. This order remains valid for 18 months from the 30th of July 2026. Further information may be obtained by contacting Network Management at tmo@southwark.gov.uk
