THE A200 GLA ROAD (CRUCIFIX LANE, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2026

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.

2. The purpose of the Order is to enable new water connection works to take place at A200 Crucifix Lane in the London Borough of Southwark.

3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping on Crucifix Lane between its junctions with Bermondsey Street and Shand Street.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 8.00 AM on the 24th August 2026 until 5.00 PM on the 26th August 2026 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:

(1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;

(2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

THE A200 GLA ROAD (BERMONDSEY STREET AND DRUID STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2026

1. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.

2. The purpose of the Order is to enable light upgrade works to take place at A200 Bermondsey Street and Druid Street in the London Borough of Southwark.

3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:

(1) entering or proceeding on Bermondsey Street between its junctions with St Thomas Street/ Crucifix Lane and Magdalen Street;

(2) entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Druid Street between its junctions with Tower Bridge Road and Barnham Street, cycles and pedestrian marshalled access will be maintained from Whites Grounds and residential marshalled vehicular access will be maintained from Brunswick Court;

The Order will also:

(3) permit two-way operation on Roper Lane between its junctions with Druid Street and Tower Bridge Road;

(4) permit all vehicles to proceed in a northerly direction on Bermondsey Street between its junctions with Morocco Street and Whites Grounds;

(5) permit all vehicles to turn right from Queen Elizabeth Street into Tooley Street westbound;

(6) permit all vehicles to use the westbound bus lane on Tooley Street between its junctions with Queen Elizabet Street and Potters Fields.

Works will be phased as such that not all restrictions may apply at any one time.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 21st August 2026 and 16th February 2027 every night between 10.00 PM and 5.00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:

(1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;

(2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs. For Bermondsey Street northbound via St Thomas Street to normal route of travel. For Druid Street closure via Tower Bridge Road, Queen Elizabeth Street, Tooley Street and Barnham Street to normal route of travel.

(WINCHESTER SQUARE)

(TEMPORARY INTRODUCTION OF LOADING BAY)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to improve highway accessibility, it has made an order to temporarily introduce restrictions detailed in point 2 of this order on Winchester Square, between Clink Street and Cathedral Street at the location described in point 2 of this order.

2. The effect of the order is to introduce an At Any Time, Monday to Sunday loading bay, on the eastern side of the carriageway, beginning 7 metres from the junction with Clink Street towards Cathedral Street for a distance of 10 metres.

3. When road markings and signs are in place, no person shall cause any vehicle to park in the loading bay described in point 2 of this order.

4. No person shall cause any vehicle to wait in the loading bay except for the purpose of continuous loading or unloading of goods.

5. This temporary traffic order will be in force from the 28th of August 2026.

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable construction and highway works by MACE or it's appointed contractor, it has made an order the effect of which is to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic from entering sections of the above named roads.
