APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF PREMISES LICENCE

Gloria Nok Tung Chan has applied to the London Borough of Lambeth to vary a Premises Licence, in respect of the following premises:

Unit 3 Dance Studio Ltd, Unit 3 Ground Floor, Canterbury Court, 1-3 Brixton Road, London SW9 6DE The nature of the variation is as follows:

The nature of the variation is as follows: To extend the permitted hours on Fridays for recorded music until 03:00, the supply of alcohol until 02:30, and the opening hours of the premises until 03:00. The application also seeks non-standard timings on New Year's Eve, with recorded music and opening hours until 03:00 on New Year's Day and the supply of alcohol until 02:30 on New Year's Day, irrespective of the day of the week on which New Year's Eve falls.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with a licensing application, and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for that offence shall not exceed level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
