

LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1) (PECKHAM RYE)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that to enable highway works by FM Conway, it intends to make an order, the effect of which is to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering part of the above named road.
2. Whilst the works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs are in place no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, proceed, stop, wait, load or unload on
 - (a) Peckham Rye, between East Dulwich Road and Homestall Road
 - (b) Peckham Rye, southbound carriageway only, between East Dulwich Road and Homestall Road.
 - (c) Peckham Rye, between Nunhead Lane and Cheltenham Road.
3. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said works.
4. The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
5. The road closure will be in place on the
 - (a) 9th of October 2026
 - (b) 10th October the to 29th of October 2026.
 - (c) 8pm to 5am on the following nights, 30th October 2026, then from 2nd November until the 13th of November 2026.
