NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Mayor and Burgesses of the London Borough of Southwark intend to exercise powers pursuant to Section 122(2A) of the Local Government Act 1972 to appropriate for planning purposes land being approximately 24,861m² in extent at Land and Buildings at Heversham House and Kentmere House and Land and Car Parking at Ilderton Road, Tustin Estate, Old Kent Road, London SE15 part of which is open space.
