3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping on:

(1) Addison Road from its junction with Bromley Common to the extended common boundary of the vehicle access point to Nos. 93 – 101 Bromley Common;

(2) Chantry Lane from its junction with Bromley Common to the extended north-eastern building line of No. 103 Bromley Common;

(3) Bloomfield Road from its junction with Bromley Common to the extended south-western building line of No. 2 Broomfield Road;

(4) Walpole Road from its junction with Bromley Common to the extended north-western building line of No. 2a Swingfield Court, Walpole Road;

(5) Bromley Common between its junctions with Chantry Lane and Walpole Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 14th September 2026 and 20th September 2026 every night 8.00 PM until 5.00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:

(1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;

(2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.

2. The purpose of the Order is to enable pedestrian guard rail repair works to take place on the A2213 Kidbrooke Park Road in the Royal Borough of Greenwich.

5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs. For A20 eastbound and north-westbound traffic via Eltham Road, Yorkshire Grey Roundabout, Westthorne Avenue and Rochester Way Relief Road westbound to normal route of travel. For A210 westbound traffic via Sidcup Road, Westthorne Avenue, Yorkshire Grey Roundabout, Westthorne Avenue and Rochester Way Relief Road westbound to normal route of travel.
