



### Statutory Notice

#### Proposal to relocate and expand the Beormund Special School.

Southwark Council publishes these proposals under section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and having regard to the DfE guidance 'Making significant changes ('prescribed alterations') to maintained schools - Statutory guidance for proposers and decision makers August 2025.

The proposal in this notice is to relocate and expand the Beormund Special School to a new site in the Peckham area of the London Borough of Southwark from January 2027.

These proposals would see:

- The relocation of the Beormund Special School to a new purpose-built site in the Peckham area.
- The expansion of the Beormund Special School through the creation of 21 new places.
- More local specialist places meaning more parental choice.

The proposals to relocate and expand Beormund Special School was published on 3rd September 2026.
